On 15 July 2024, KP Sharma Oli, the leader of the CPN (UML), was appointed as the new Prime Minister, although he had tried to abuse the parliamentary system and the constitution only three years earlier with the aim of retaining personal power. His cabinet initially comprises 22 persons: 10 from the Nepali Congress, 9 from the UML and three from two smaller parties. The disregard for the social inclusion prescribed by the constitution is breathtaking. Exactly half belong to the Bahun caste, of which 10 are males (Only to remember: male Bahuns make up less than six per cent of the total population). In fact, only two women are represented, both from the Khas Arya group. Dalits are not included at all, although this oppressed population group is significantly more numerous than the Bahuns. Muslims are also not represented, although their number in Nepal is not much lower than that of male Bahuns. The significantly higher average age of the ministers is also striking. One Dalit woman was later introduced as Minister of State. On 21 April
